At the same time, I declare that I have been informed that:

1. The administrator of my personal data is the Biiku Bunka Kyokai with its headquarters in 5-19-4 Takenotsuka, Adachi-ku, Tokyo, Japan.
2. The personal data I have provided will be transferred to Japan (a so-called third country) and the adequate and appropriate safeguards required by the regulations on personal data protection will be in place.
3. My personal data will be processed for the period necessary for the implementation of the Exhibition in accordance with article 6 section 1 letter a of the General Data Protection Regulation ("RODO"). Personal data will be stored for the period of the Exhibition, its promotion and summary on the websites and social media posts of the Exhibition organizers, and for the period required by law.
4. The basis for the processing of my personal data is my consent to the processing of personal data.
5. I have the right to access the content of my data and correct, delete, transfer or restrict its processing.
6. If I believe that the processing of my personal data has violated the provisions of RODO, I have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection.
7. My data will not be processed by automated means, including profiling.
8. Providing personal data is voluntary, but it is necessary for my involvement in the Exhibition.

I also declare that I have read and accept all of the terms and conditions stipulated in the Exhibition regulations.
